# ? What is the deadline to submit an abstract?

# • What type of abstract should I submit?

If your abstract is basic science research and you <u>do not</u> want it published in the JACI, it should be submitted to **Discovery** 

If your abstract describes 1-4 individuals in a clinical setting, it should be submitted as a **Case Report.** *Case reports are for first-year Fellows-in-Training, medical students and residents only* 

All other scientific abstracts should be submitted to the main meeting

### ? Can I submit an abstract if I'm not an author?

Yes, you can submit an abstract on behalf of others. Make sure you list yourself as a "Submitter Only" in the submission.

#### **?** Can I make changes to my abstract after submitting?

Changes can be made to a submitted abstract until the submission deadline. <u>Absolutely no changes</u> can be made to an abstract after the deadline.

## **?** What if my abstract is accepted but I can't attend?

Another non-industry author may present in your place. The change must be communicated to <u>cme@aaaai.org</u> and if the abstract was accepted for an oral presentation, the new presenter must complete a disclosure.

# **?** Can I submit more than one abstract?

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Each primary author can submit up to three abstracts or case reports.

## When will I find out if my abstract has been accepted?

Notifications will be sent to the primary author in early December of 2025.
