

2013 AAAAI Annual Meeting Poster Presentation Information

The AAAAI is looking forward to your participation and poster presentation at the 2013 Annual Meeting.

You should have already received a notification about your poster presentation which includes the date your poster is to be presented, the session in which it is programmed and the poster board number to which it has been assigned.

Please be sure to set-up your poster on the appropriate poster board between 7:00am and 8:00am the morning of your session. Your poster will remain on display throughout the day, and must be dismantled between 6:00pm and 7:00pm that evening. **Posters not dismantled by 7:30pm will be discarded.** You are asked to be present at your poster board from 9:45am - 10:45am on the day your poster presentation is scheduled, to discuss your research and answer questions from meeting attendees.

The poster hall location is in Exhibit Hall C, Street Level, San Antonio Convention Center.

Poster Preparation Guidelines

The following are poster preparation guidelines for authors whose abstract was accepted for poster presentation at the 2013 Annual Meeting.

The usable space on these poster boards is 46" high x 94" wide. This is the surface space which one could insert a thumbtack.

- Posters should be readable by viewers from up to five feet away.
- The message should be clear and understandable without oral explanation.
- Illustrations, labels, etc. must be attached to the poster board with thumbtacks, which will be available in the poster area.
- A copy of your abstract should be posted in the upper left-hand corner of the poster board.
- A label indicating the abstract number, abstract title, author and their affiliation should be placed at the top of the poster board, to the right of the abstract.

A label listing the funding source(s) must be displayed in the lower right-hand corner of the poster board.

Poster presenters **do NOT** receive waived registration for the meeting.

In order to load the presentations for all the session's speakers onto a single computer, it will be necessary to collect your final PowerPoint file in advance of the session. Please bring your presentation on a CD-ROM, jump drive or Zip disk to the on-site Speaker Resource Room at the Pennsylvania Convention Center no later than 2 hours prior to your session's starting time. Failure to do so may prevent your presentation from being shown during your session.

The Featured Poster session will be held on Sunday evening, February 24th, 2013, from 4:30pm – 6:30pm in the Concourse Level, Park View, San Antonio Convention Center.

Please be sure to set-up your poster on the appropriate poster board (these will be identified by your poster number) between 2:00pm and 3:00pm on the afternoon of Sunday, February 24th. Your poster will remain on display throughout the weekend. It is mandatory that your poster be left on display for the course of the meeting. If you are unable to hang your poster that afternoon please contact Amanda Buckley, abuckley@aaaai.org, to arrange for staff assistance.

These abstracts will be facilitated by Interest Section leadership who will initiate and promote discussion among the authors and attendees. You are asked to be present with your poster so you can participate in the discussion and answer any questions attendees and facilitators may have.

Poster Presentation Guidelines

The following are poster preparation guidelines for authors whose abstract was accepted for poster presentation at the 2013 Annual Meeting. **The usable space on these poster boards is 46” high x 94” wide (Landscape orientation). This is the surface space which one could insert a push pin/tack. The following guidelines are recommended when organizing your poster:**

- Posters should be readable by viewers from up to five feet away.
- The message should be clear and understandable without oral explanation.
- Illustrations, labels, etc. must be attached to the poster board with thumbtacks, which will be available in the poster area.
- A copy of your abstract should be posted in the upper left-hand corner of the poster board.
- A label indicating the abstract number, abstract title, author and the affiliation should be placed at the top of the poster board, to the right of the abstract. A label listing the funding source(s) must be displayed in the lower right-hand corner of the poster board.
