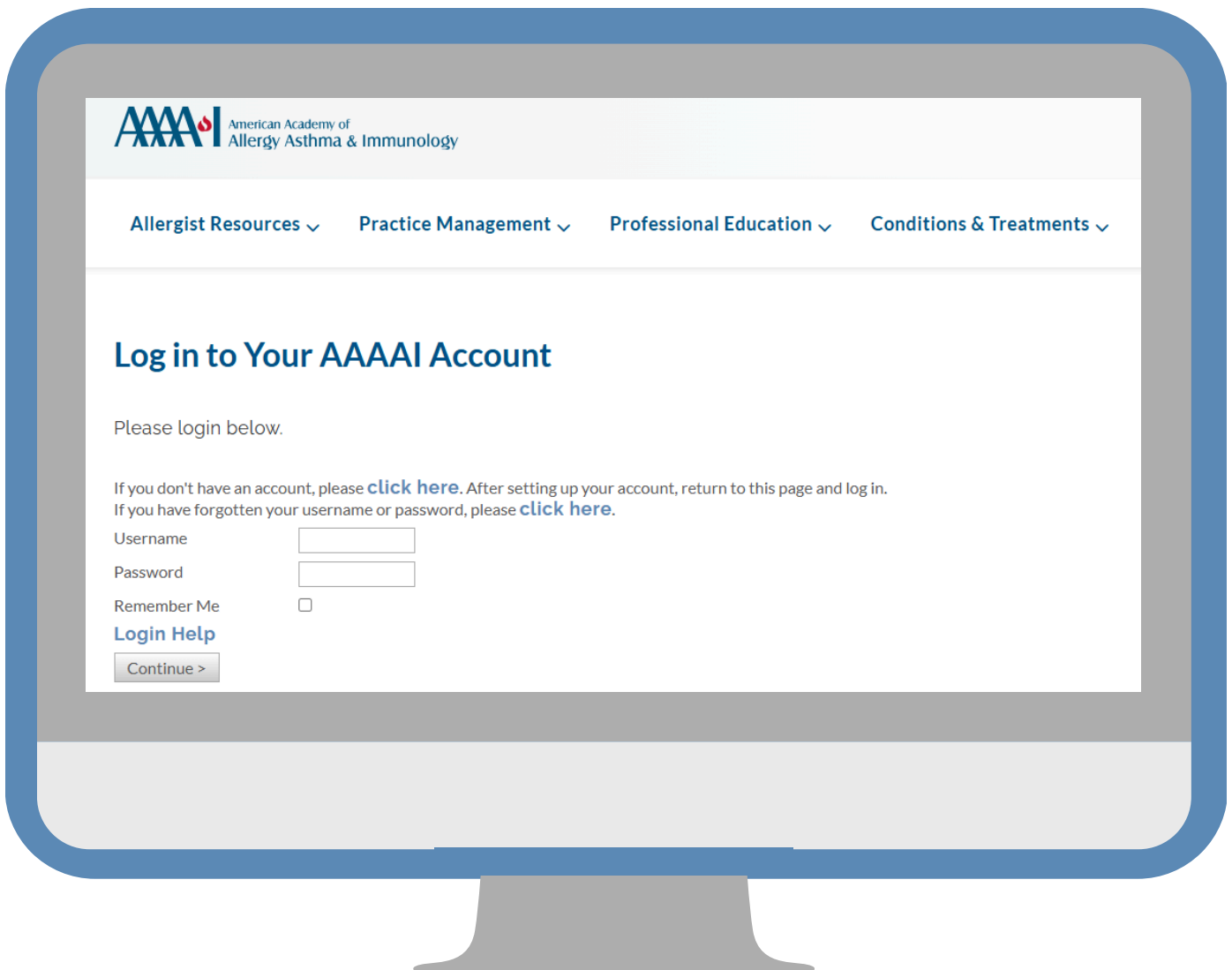




Claim Credit on Your Computer

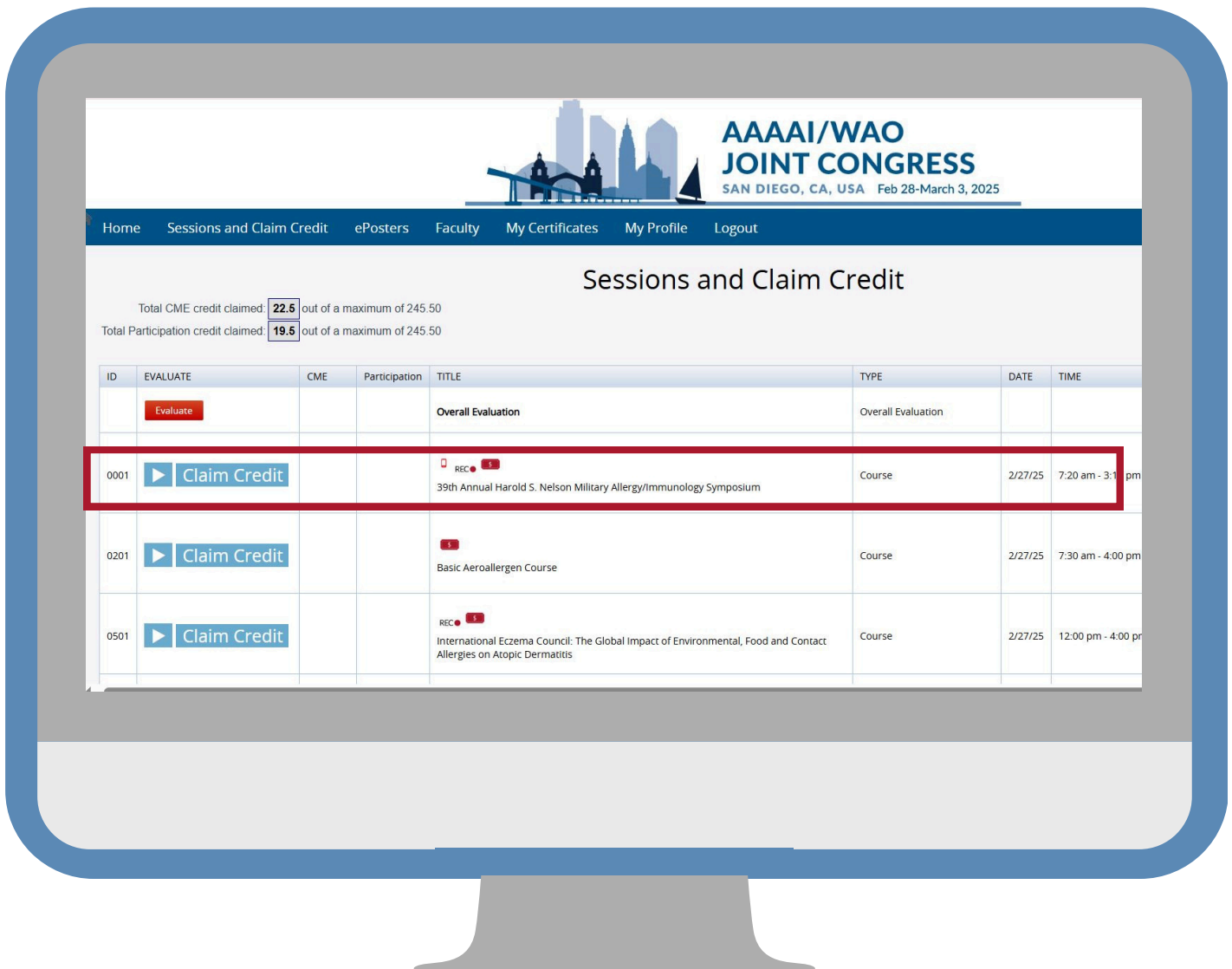

The Overall Evaluation *must* be completed before you can print your certificates or have your credits reported to the ABAI.

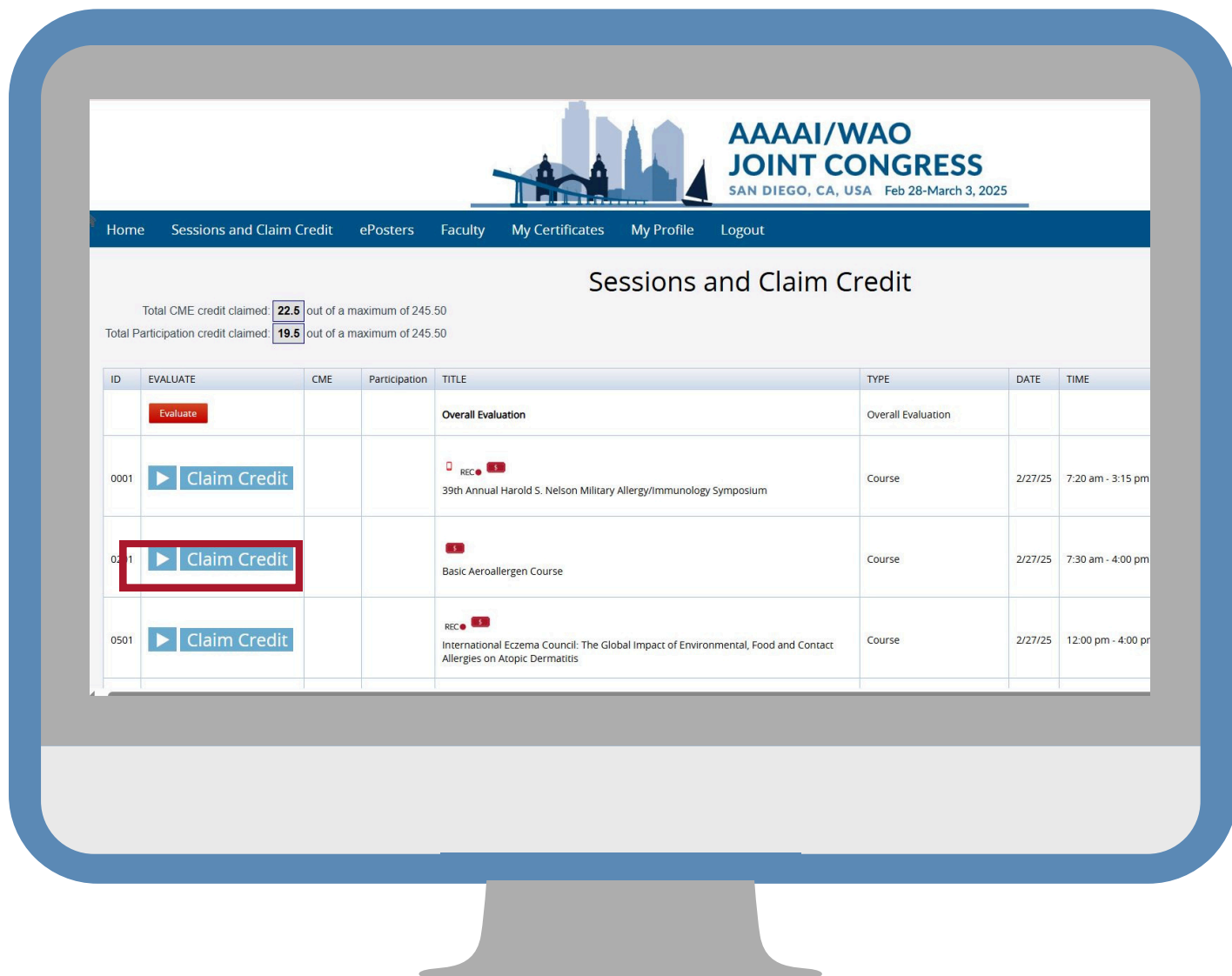

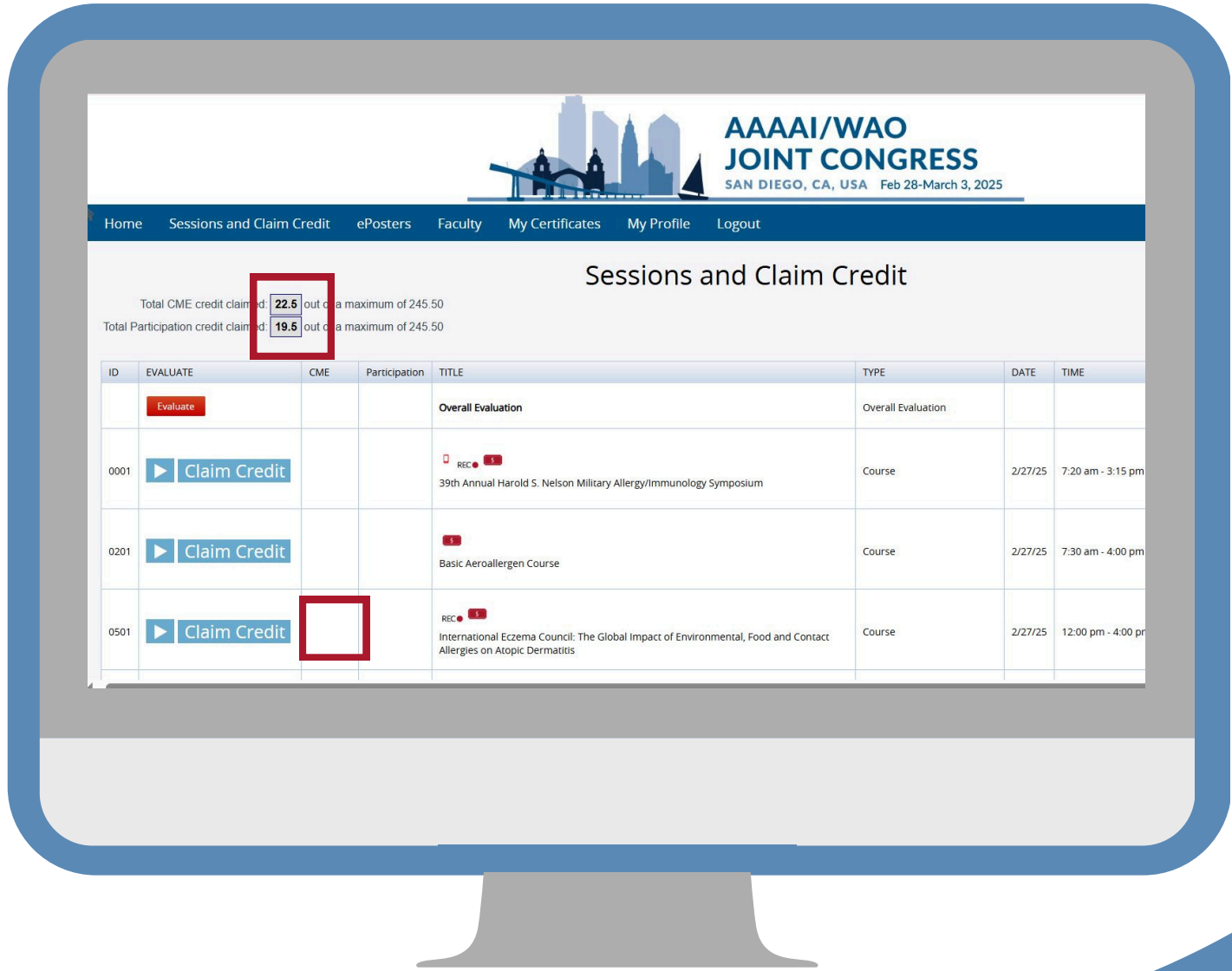
- 5 Complete the session evaluation. All presenters need to be evaluated before claiming credit. If you did not hear a lecture, select “NA” for that presenter.
